

From Lexington (automobile): I-64 to U.S. 127 (Interchange No. 53); south 2 miles toward Lawrenceburg and turn right on Evergreen Rd. (KY 1665), at a stop light; 2 miles and turn left on South Benson Rd. which is not a crossroad, but leads off to left during a curve. Go .9 miles and just across a small bridge, and turn left between two black board fences that run approximately 20 feet and where the mailbox says "Bradley" and "855" and go up a blacktop road which leads to house and horse barn.

From Lexington (if van or pulling horse trailer): I-64 to U.S. 127 (Interchange No. 53). South toward Lawrenceburg for 3.8 miles and 1.5 miles past the stop light at Evergreen Road (KY 1665). Turn right at Green Wilson Road (KY 2820) where there is a grocery. 2.0 miles to a gate (1996 on mailbox) with two stone (not brick) posts and follow blacktop road .3 miles to Marshall house or turn left just before reaching house and follow road across creek to metal horse barn.

From Louisville (by car): I-64 to KY 151, just past mile post 47 and go right or south 1.5 miles toward Lawrenceburg to South Benson Road (across from Avenstoke Road). Turn left and go 1.5 miles to blacktop road leading up hill between two black board fences and before you get to mailbox that says "Bradley" and "855". Follow road to Bradley house or metal horse barn.

From Louisville (van or with horse trailer): I-64 to KY 151 and just past mile post 47 turn right or south toward Lawrenceburg for three miles and turn left on Green Wilson Road (KY 2820) which is 1.5 miles past South Benson and the first blacktop road past South Benson. Go .7 miles to two stone posts (1996 on mailbox) and turn left and follow blacktop road .3 miles to Marshall house or turn just before reaching house and follow road across creek to metal horse barn.

From Lawrenceburg, Danville, or Bluegrass Parkway: Stay on KY 151 (turn left from U.S. 127 at stoplight which is next light past KY 44) through Alton and 2.0 miles past Alton and just past 2 mile marker turn right on Green Wilson Rd. (KY 2820). Go .7 miles to 2 stone posts (1996). Follow blacktop road .3 miles to Marshall's house or turn just before house and follow road across creek (concrete bottom) to metal horse barn or to Bradley house.

From Frankfort: Follow U.S. 60 from its intersection at the traffic signal at U.S. 127 intersection for 3.6 miles to a commercial building. Turn left (KY 1665) for 1/10 mile. Make right turn and then an immediate left turn on Evergreen Rd. (KY 1665) and go 1.6 miles to South Benson Road which leads off to the right in the middle of a curve. Go .9 miles and just across small bridge and turn left on blacktop road leading between two black board fences and just past mailbox which says "Bradley" and "855" and follow road to Bradley house or to metal horse barn. Can also use U.S. 127 as in first directions above, but one mile further.
